- 3. MBU accepts the Associates in Human Services Degree from BRCC; this degree waives all General Education requirements from MBU and requires that students complete all social work prerequisites and major requirements only.
- 4. To transfer courses, students must earn a grade of "C" or better in BRCC courses.
